An atom is the smallest possible amount of matter which still retains its identity as a chemical element, consisting of a nucleus surrounded by electrons. Atoms combine to form molecules, which then interact to form solids, gases, or liquids. For example, water is composed of hydrogen and oxygen atoms that have combined to form water molecules. Atoms are made up of particles called protons, neutrons, and electrons, which are responsible for the mass and charge of atoms. An atom is composed of two regions: the nucleus, which is in the center of the atom and contains protons and neutrons, and the outer region of the atom, which holds its electrons in orbit around the nucleus. Protons and neutrons have approximately the same mass. Each electron has a negative charge equal to the positive charge of a proton. Neutrons are uncharged particles found within the nucleus.
